



Guided walks in Northwest Sutherland August 2016

All walks £4.50 adults, £3.50 concessions. Families £15.

Tues 2nd ... Oldshoremore dunes and beach walk; masses of wild flowers on the machair, beautiful views and beach. Meet at Oldshoremore car park 4miles north of Kinlochbervie at 10:30am – 1pm.
Map Ref NC 203584.

Thurs 11th ... Scourie; garnets & dikes, coastal walk around Scourie bay, wild flowers, great views, seabirds, bit of geology, signs of otters. Meet at the beach bird hide at 10:30am – 1pm. Map ref NC151446.

Fri 12th ...Faraid head dunes & coast by Durness; beautiful walk along Balnakeil beach returning through the amazing dunes; wildlife, local history and wildflowers.
Meet at Balnakeil car park at 10:30am – 1pm approx. Map Ref NC 392686.

Wed 17th ...Kyle of Durness, wild flower walk; leisurely 2hr walk around the coast amongst a myriad of flowers with great scenery and wildlife. Meet at Durness golf course car park at 10:30am.
Map ref NC 389687.

Fri 19th ... Kylestrome by Kylesku - Rock Stop Ramble, leisurely lochside walk down Glen Dubh looking at the geology [the Glen Coul Thrust], plants, great views, wildlife. 3hrs approx.
On behalf of UNESCO Northwest Highland Geopark.
Meet at the Kylestrome estate car park 1km north of the bridge at 10am. Map ref NC211351.

Tues. 23rd...The Watch hill & Ben Tongue, 10.30am - 2.00pm. Rough hill walking (307m), with outstanding views across the Kyle of Tongue, moorland plants and birds.
Meet at Coldbackie lay-by on the A836, 3mils east of Tongue. Map ref: NC 610601.

Thurs. May 25th ... Scourie - Loch Leathad Trail, 10.30am - 1.30pm
Guided walk over moorland track amongst lochs and woodland. Fine views over Scourie bay.
Meet at Scourie old Depot Road 300m south of village sign. Map ref: NC 157437.

Tues.30th ...Castle Bharraich & beyond - by Tongue. Hill walk to this enigmatic ruin and over the hill [126m], returning by the quiet road; amazing views, woodland, moorland, birds & wild flowers. Meet at the village car park, map ref NC 592566, near the bank at 10:30am – 1pm.
