



Guided walks – Northwest Highlands September 2015

Adults £4 concessions £3. Family £10.

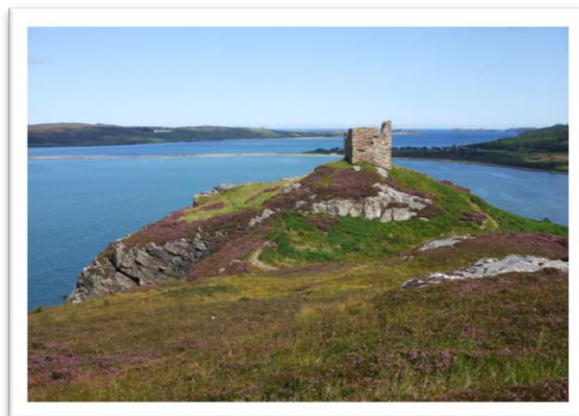
Thursday 10th ...Scourie – garnets & dikes; a guided coastal walk with great views, moorland, seabirds, crofts, bit of geology, garnets & gneiss, rough walking – no paths. Meet at Scourie beach bird hide. Time 10.30am – 1.30pm approx. Grid ref NC 152446.

Tuesday 15th ... near Tongue; The watch hill [307m], spectacular views across the Kyle, moorland and loch, rough walking. Meet at Coldbackie lay-by on the A836. Grid ref NC 592566, Time 10.30am – 12.30pm. approx.

Thursday 17th ...Scourie, Cliffs and caves; peaceful coastal walk, fine views, seabirds, signs of otters. Meet at Scourie Free Church at the south end of the village. Time 10.30am – 1pm. Grid ref NC 152466.

Friday 18th ...Kyle of Durness; Beautiful, fairly leisurely coastal walk, seabirds, good views, flowers and secluded beaches. Meet at the Golf course car park at Balnakeil. Time 10.30am - 1.30 pm. Grid Ref NC 389687.

Tuesday 29th...Tongue; Castle Bharraich & beyond, hill walk to this enigmatic ruin then over the hill, returning by the quiet road back into Tongue. Time 10:30am – 1.30pm. Meet at the village car park near the bank. Grid ref, NC 592566.
