Thurs. 8th... Scourie; garnets & dikes, coastal walk around Scourie bay, wild flowers, great views, seabirds, bit of geology, signs of otters. Meet at the beach bird hide at 10:30am – 1pm. Map ref NC151446.

Fri. 16th... **Kylestrome** by Kylesku - **Rock Stop Ramble**; A leisurely lochside walk down Glen Dubh, looking at the geology [the Glen Coul Thrust], wild flowers, great views, wildlife. 3hrs approx. Meet at Kylestrome estate car park about 1m north of the bridge at 10am. Map ref NC 218346 On behalf of the UNESCO Northwest Highland Geopark.

Thurs. 22^{nd...}The Watch hill & Ben Tongue; 10.30am - 2.00pm. Rough hill walking (307m), with outstanding views across the Kyle of Tongue, moorland plants and birds. Meet at Coldbackie lay-by on the A836, 3mls east of Tongue. Map ref: NC 610601.

Fri. 23rd...Faraid head dunes & coast by Durness; beautiful walk along Balnakeil beach returning through the amazing dunes; wildlife, local history and wildflowers.

Meet at Balnakeil car park at 10:30am – 1pm approx. Map Ref NC 392686.

Thurs. 29th ... **Scourie – north shore,** 10.30am - 2pm approx. Fine views over Scourie bay, rough walking [no paths], heather and moorland wildlife. Meet at Scourie pier car park. Map ref: NC 155449.
