## EXERCISE NOTIFICATION

### NOTIFICATION OF MILITARY EXERCISE

#### 11-30 MARCH 2012

The MoD will be conducting an exercise involving helicopters and ground troops between 11 - 30 March 2012. Activity can be expected in the following general areas:

Borders: St Mary's Loch and Roxburghe Estate Morebattle

Highland: Kylesku - Glendhu Forest area, Ben More Forest area, Lairg - Loch Shin area, Cape Wrath - Durness - Eriboll - Kinlochbervie, (North-West Sutherland).

Isle of Mull: Ardmeanach area.

Out of hours flying has been authorised and noise disturbance may be experienced in some locations. The ground element of the exercise will deploy in conjunction with helicopter operations. Personnel will carry weapons and blank ammunition. Tactical activity will be conducted as part of the localised ground deployment at locations where permission has been granted to do so.

The purpose of this circular is to provide notice of military-related activity, particularly helicopter low flying and the presence of troops. All personnel involved with the exercise will be briefed on the requirement to avoid disturbance to livestock and damage to property together with the procedures for reporting incidents and complaints.
