Mondays 14th, 21st & 28th ; Durness Puffins; guided walk to visit the small colony of puffins at Faraid head, walking across beautiful Balnakeil beach and returning through the amazing dunes. Meet at Balnakeil beach car park at 2pm. Grid ref NC 392687. Adults £3 concessions £2.family £8. Lasts 2hrs.

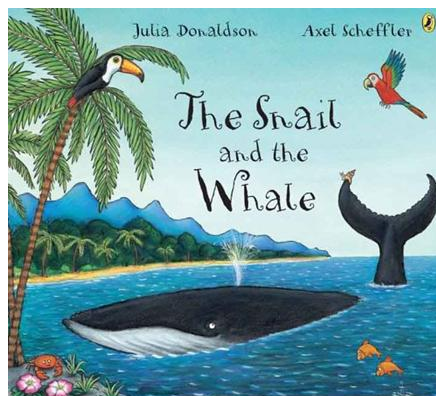

Wednesday 23rd ; The Snail & the Whale Theatre Workshop 2 – 4pm. Who is it for? Families with children around 4-10 years. Meet at Sangomore Beach visitor centre, Durness.
