



Guided walks in northwest Sutherland October - 2010

Friday 1st ... Scourie Bronze age settlement. Guided hill walk, over rough ground; burnt mounds and hut circles. Good scenery, moorland wildlife. 3hrs approx. Meet at village car park opposite shop at 10am. Adults £3 conc £2. An event for Highland Council archaeology festival.

Tues 5th ... Castle Bharraich by Tongue. 2hr Guided walk to this interesting ruin. Superb views over the Kyle of Tongue. Meet at Village car park opposite Royal Bank at 10am. Adults £3 conc £2. An event for Highland Council archaeology festival.

Tues 19th 2,000yr old Wheelhouse, above Laid near Durness. Guided hill walk [280m] over rough, usually wet ground. Fine views, moorland wildlife, overlooking Loch Eriboll. 3hrs approx. Meet at old roadside quarry 7 miles east of Durness. NC 421603.

Thurs 21st Beinn Ceannabeinne. Guided hill walk 383m. Over track and rough ground. 3hrs approx. superb all round views, moorland wildlife. Meet at Ceannabeinne beach car park at 10am. 4 mls east of Durness. NC 443 654. £3 conc £2
