



Northwest Guided walks. Adults £3 conc£2. September...2012

Tues 4th ..Faraid head dunes & beach by Durness. Interesting walk amongst the dunes; flowers, bones, birds, views and sand! Ending with a walk back along a beautiful beach. 2½hrs approx. Meet at 10.30am. @ Balnakeil beach car park.

Thurs 6th ...Scourie bay – north shore. Coastal walk, no paths - rough ground, superb views, moorland flowers, seabirds, lochans. 3hrs approx. Meet at Scourie pier car park @ 10;30am.

Wed 12th ...Talmine...very beautiful coastal walk to Port Vasco and back. Meet at 10.30am. at Talmine pier [please do not block access] 3hrs approx.

Thurs 13th...Scourie cliffs. Undulating coastal walk with excellent views, caves, seabirds, otter signs. Meet @ Free church car park at south end of village at 10.30am.2.5hrs approx.

Wed 19th ...Castle Bharraich by Tongue; short walk to this enigmatic ruin and beyond, with fantastic views, woodland, flowers. Meet at village car park by the bank at 10.30am.

Thurs 20th ...Scourie coast – dikes & garnets. 2½hr coastal walk, fine views, seabirds, bit of geology, wild flowers, signs of otters. Meet @ Scourie beach bird hide at 10.30am.

Wed 26th...Ceannabienne ‘clearance’ township, Durness. Leisurely 2hr walk, bit of local history, fine views, wildlife, gorgeous beach. Meet at roadside lay by 4miles east of Durness. Map Ref NC 436 657. @ 10.30am.

Fri 28th ...Durness - Smoo cave – Arty hours; an invitation to create a masterpiece; painting, drawing etc.2hrs approx. Part of the ‘Wild North Festival’ events. Meet at Smoo cave car park at 10am. Booking preferred – materials provided. Tel 511756
